

Klickitat County
2018 Annual Title VI Accomplishment and Update Report

In conformance with Chapter 28 of the Local Agency Guidelines, please accept this document as the County's yearly report of Title VI accomplishments for 2018.

1. There were no changes to the racial/gender composition of those persons involved in the transportation decision making. Public Works organization chart is attached.
2. Based on current information from the Office of Financial Management and the US Census the 2015 County population was 21,000.
3. The 2015 Population by race was White 93.3%, American Indian / Alaska Native 2.3%, and 4.4% other races. 22.8% of the population is 65 or older. The estimated Median Household Income for 2015 was \$48,319. No change in the demographics is noted.
3. Public outreach activities in 2018 consisted of advertising and public notices in the two weekly newspapers located within Klickitat County. Interpretive services are provided at public hearings if requested. Additionally, the County used a combination of letters, flyers, and open house meetings to communicate with residents directly affected by projects.

b. In addition to advertising in the local papers, contracting opportunities were advertised on Builders Exchange of Washington, Inc., and on the County's website.
c. Contracts and public notices included a Title VI Non-Discrimination statement.
5. No transportation projects were identified as impacting minority and/or low-income Environmental Justice (EJ) populations.
6. ROW Acquisitions resulted in no displaced citizens. The number of minority, low-income, elderly and disabled persons affected by ROW acquisition were not identified in 2018.
7. There were no Title VI related complaints in 2018.
