Total Valuation Fees listed in Table 15-A shall increase by 2% annually, effective October 1 of each year.

Fees listed under “Other Inspections and Fees” shall increase \$5.00 every 3 years at intervals to coincide with Building Code cycle changes as per the State of Washington’s scheduling. For the installation or relocation of each floor furnace, including vent 15.40
For the installation or relocation of each suspended heater, recessed wall heater or floor-mounted unit heater 15.40
- 2. **Appliance Vents**
For the installation, relocation or replacement of each appliance vent installed and not included in an appliance permit..... 7.55
- 2. **Repairs or Additions**
For the repair of, alteration of, or addition to each heating appliance, refrigeration unit, cooling unit, absorption unit, or each heating, cooling, absorption or evaporation cooling system, including installation of controls regulated by the Mechanical Code 14.25
- 3. **Boilers, Compressors and Absorption Systems**
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor to and including 3 horsepower (10.6kW), or each absorption system to and including 100,000 Btu/h (29.3kW) 15.29
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over three horsepower (10.6kW) to and including 15 horsepower (52.7kW), or each absorption system over 100,000 Btu/h (29.3 kW) to and including 500,000 Btu/h (146.6kW) 28.24
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 15 horsepower (52.7 kW) to and including 30 horsepower (105.5 kW) or each absorption system over 500,000 Btu/h (146.6 kW) to and including 1,000,000 Btu/h (293.1 kW) 38.76
For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 30 horsepower (105.5 kW) to and including 50 horsepower (176 kW), or each absorption system over 1,000,000 Btu/h (293.1 kW) to and including 1,750,000 Btu/h(512.9 kW) 57.69

Mechanical Permit Fees listed in Table 15-C of the current fee schedule shall increase by 2% annually, effective October 1 of each year.

Plumbing Permit Fees listed in Table 15-D of the current fee schedule shall increase by 2% annually, effective October 1 of each year.

*When a plan or other data is required to be submitted, a plan review fee shall be paid at the time of submitting plans, data and specifications for review. Said plan review fee shall be 65% of the permit fee in the table above. Plan review fees are separate fees and are in addition to the permit fees listed in the table above. Where plans are incomplete or changed so as to require additional plan review, or where re-inspection is required, an additional fee shall be charged as per “Other Inspections and Fees” listed in Table 15-A of the current fee schedule.

TABLE 15-G

DEMOLITION, CHANGE IN USE, FIREWORKS STANDS, & FLAMMABLE/COMBUSTIBLE LIQUID STORAGE TANKS

Demolition Permits. The fee for a demolition permit shall be \$55 per 1,000 square feet, or portion thereof, of a building, up to a maximum of \$550.00.

Change In Use. Change in use not creating a change in occupancy shall be \$55.00. Change in use resulting in a change in occupancy shall incur fees based upon the square footage valuation and fees as listed in Tables 15-A and 15-B of the current fee schedule. Fees calculated will be based upon the difference of the group the occupancy falls within as compared to the previous occupancy group, but shall in no case result in a refund if the new occupancy falls within a lesser valuation group.

Retail Sales of Fireworks. The fee for retail fireworks stands shall be \$55.00 per sales display stand.

Flammable/Combustible Liquid Storage Tanks (Placement and/or removal). The fee for placement and/or removal of a tank shall be \$55.00 for each tank over 125 gallons.

Fee Increase Schedule

- A. Fees in KCC Title 15, Chapter 15.48, Section 15.48.010, Section 15.48.020, Section 15.48.030, , Section 15.48.040, and Table 15-A, Table 15-B, Table 15-C and Table 15-D of the current fee schedule shall increase by 2% annually, effective October 1 of each year.
- B. Fees as listed under “Other Inspections and Fees” in Table 15-A of the current fee schedule and listed in , Chapter 15.48, Section 15.48.050, including Table 15-F and Table 15-G of the current fee schedule shall increase by \$5.00 every three years at intervals to coincide with Building Code cycle changes as per the State of Washington’s scheduling.
- C. A fee study shall occur every 6 years with comparable counties/jurisdictions, and be provided to the Board of County Commissioners.

TABLE 16
FACTORY ASSEMBLED STRUCTURES

1. Permanent or temporary placement shall be \$250.00 for the first section and \$100.00 for each section thereafter. The fee for the first section shall increase by \$25.00 every 3 years at intervals to coincide with Building Code cycle changes as per the State of Washington scheduling.
2. A fee of \$55.00 per inspection is established for each additional inspection when requested, or re-inspections. The fee shall increase by \$5.00 every 3 years at intervals to coincide with Building Code cycle changes as per the State of Washington scheduling.
3. Fees for basements under a factory assembled structure shall be calculated as any other building permit using KCC Title 15, Table 15-A and Table 15-B and shall increase by 2% annually, effective October 1 of each year. Fees as listed under “Other Inspections and Fees” shall increase by \$5.00 every 3 years at intervals to coincide with Building Code cycle changes as per the State of Washington scheduling.
4. The Building Department fee for title elimination shall be \$55.00 each. The fee for title elimination shall increase by \$5.00 every 3 years at intervals to coincide with Building Code cycle changes as per the State of Washington scheduling.
5. Fees for permit extensions, in excess of 2 extensions shall be charged \$55.00 per approved extension. Extension fee increases shall be as noted in KCC Title, 15, Section 15.08.040(A).
6. When a Factory Assembled Structure, for which a permit is required, has been placed prior to obtaining a permit, the fee schedule may be doubled and the structure may or may not be subject to relocation.
