Did you know that we have a local composting facility in Klickitat County? After the holidays are done you can take your tree to [Dirt Hugger](#). The trees must be real trees, no artificial, with all tinsel and ornaments removed. By choosing this option you are helping reduce the amount of waste going to the landfill as well as by allowing the tree to be recycled and reused.

We are working on a local collection program, that will allow you to drop off your trees at a local drop-site and we will transport them to Dallesport. Stay tuned! We will send an email out with the details as soon as they are confirmed.

Recycling Tips

RECYCLE RIGHT EMPTY, CLEAN, & DRY

- YES!**
- Mixed paper (larger than 3")
 - Cardboard & Paper Boxes
 - Aluminum & Tin Cans (lids larger than 3" or placed inside of the can)
 - Plastic Bottles, Jugs, & Tubs (lids larger than 3" or screwed onto item)



- NO!**
- No direct food contact packaging
 - Foil
 - Plastic film or bags
 - Plastic, unless it is a bottle, jug, or tub
 - Clamshell packaging
 - Disposable/compostable products
 - Styrofoam
