Five ballots were presented that were returned with no signatures and the Board rejected them. The Board rejected those ballot and signed the report (attached).

A report was presented for the four ballots that were returned late in the Goldendale Drop Box and the Board signed the report (attached).

Documentation was presented detailing the Goldendale Drop Box closing issue that was discussed at the February 20th meeting (attached).

Documentation was presented detailing the Lyle Drop Box closing issue and new procedures were created to help prevent this issue from happening in the future (attached).

The Reconciliation Report was presented and reviewed. There were no discrepancies to report and the Board approved the report (attached).

The Oath of Authenticity and Certification of the Canvassing Board was presented and signed (attached).

The Klickitat County Canvassing Board Delegation of Authority was presented and signed (attached). The delegation was updated to reflect new employees since the last delegation.

The Elections Administrator let the board know that Roosevelt School District had submitted a resolution calling for an April 24, 2018, Special Election.

Documentation of Goldendale Drop Box Closing Issue

On February 13, 2018, at 8 p.m. two Auditor's Office staff closed the Goldendale Drop Box. One staff member opened the bottom of the box and shined a flashlight inside the box to ensure all ballots were collected. The other staff member removed the upper locks and closed the each flap on the box. She then replaced the locks but put them back in the same holes instead of in the upper holes which would prevent the flaps from being reopened and ballots being deposited.

On February 16, 2018, at 2 p.m. an Auditor's Office staff member drove by the Goldendale Drop Box and noticed the locks seemed to be in the wrong position. She parked and walked to the box to double check. She went into the office and immediately reported this to the Auditor. The Auditor went out to the box and placed the locks in the correct position. She opened the bottom of the box and discovered that four ballots were inside.

On February 20, 2018, the Auditor presented the four late ballots to the Canvassing Board during the Canvassing Board Meeting. Due to the fact the ballots were clearly received after 8 p.m. on February 13, 2018, the Canvassing Board rejected the four ballots. The ballots were returned by:
